

## WHAT do I need to get a PRC through the CALGARY Police Service (CPS)?

You need two pieces of government issued identification, at least one piece of which shows a photo of you.

For both ePIC and in-person applications, you require a PRC request sheet so that you can be "associated" with Scouts Canada (and so that the search fee, if applicable, will be paid on your behalf). The sheet is available to Group (Area and Council) Commissioners through the Prairie Service Centre. It must be completed then signed your Commissioner for presentation to CPS.

## WHAT do I need to get a PRC through the LETHBRIDGE Regional Police Service (LRPS)?

You need two pieces of government issued identification, at least one piece of which shows a photo of you and at least one must have a birthdate.

- National Defense Card
- Provincial Healthcare Card
- Canadian National Institute for the Blind ID card
- Aboriginal Status Card
- Birth Certificate
- Passport
- Marriage Certificate
- Citizenship Card
- Immigration papers
- Permanent Residence Card
- AISH
- Firearms License
- Social Insurance Card
- WIN Card
- Nexus Card

## WHAT do I need to get a PRC through the Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP)?

Please be prepared to present **two** pieces of identification from the following lists;

**Any two of the following;**

### Picture ID

- Driver's License
- Passport
- Citizenship Card
- If you do not have any of the above;
- Métis Card (check with your local detachment to see if they will accept this card)
- FAC (check with your local detachment to see if they will accept this card)

**Or one piece of picture ID from the above list and one of the following;**

- Alberta Health Care Card
- Birth Certificate

**Identification requirements are specific to government produced and controlled documentation.**
