To whom it may concern

This letter confirms _____ is a new or returning volunteer who requires a Police Record Check (PRC) as part of the volunteer screening process. The individual will be working with youth members age 5 to 26.

Scouts Canada screens all adult volunteers for all positions and reviews suitability of all volunteers on an ongoing basis. As part of this process the adult volunteer is required to complete a Police Record Check (PRC), which includes a "Criminal Record Information" and a "Criminal Record Check for a sexual offence for which a pardon has been granted or issued". Persons with child abuse related convictions are not acceptable for membership in Scouts Canada regardless of their current status.

Scouts Canada was incorporated by an Act of the Canadian Parliament on June 12, 1914 as a non-profit charitable organization.
